Remember to use your MYFW app on your phone to report city code violations, high weeds and grass, potholes, streetlights burned out, dead animals, etc.



The dredging of French Lake has begun. This is part of the bond program that was voted on a few years back. So far, five huge bags of muck have been removed from the bottom of French Lake. They look like submarines! (See the photos below.) The dredging is expected to remove nine of these filled bags. You'll also notice that the turtles have made temporary homes on the dredging crates.

Thankfully, the waterfowl continue their normal routine while the dredging is taking place. They are glad to still have water after the drought that they have been experiencing.

Thank You Citizens on Patrol Volunteers

The Fort Worth City Council has established the Office of Police Oversight Monitor to provide the city information on oversight and accountability, intake complaints and commendations, investigate complaints, review policies and procedures, make recommendations, and more. If you need to file a complaint or make a commendation, call 817-392-6535 or email policeoversight@fortworthtexas.gov.

Citizens on Patrol has a new training class starting October 7th. You must register for the class by Sept. 28th. If you are interested, call Warner Filley at 817-392-3418 or email him at Warner.Filley@fortworthtexas.gov.

It is always a good idea to have a community of citizen patrollers so that we can provide a community presence to would-be criminals. Statistics show that a strong well-knit community is the best deterrence to keeping crime from moving into our neighborhood. It is not difficult to become a Citizen on Patrol member —pass a background check and complete the training class.



The patrolling is not dangerous! You will not be put in harm's way. Patrollers are trained to only call 911 when we see something criminal going on. We are not allowed to speak to would-be offenders or carry weapons; we are just to be a presence in the neighborhood. You are also provided with magnetic signs to put on your car.

FWPD also has a community camera program where you can register your home security cameras with FWPD. Register your cameras at: https://police.fortworthtexas.gov/OnlineServices/Cameras. You will ONLY be contacted if there was a crime near your location. Call 817-392-3405 for more info!

Crime is low in CandleRidge; let's keep it that way!! Remember to participate in National Night Out. See page 7 for more information on it. Also, consider installing a locking mailbox to help keep your mail secure and to help deter mail theft.

CandleRidge residents are strongly encouraged to support the City's police establishment and further strongly encouraged to join the Citizens on Patrol program. With the decrease in pandemic cancellations, training for the program has increased. Cíty Affaírs

At our annual HOA meeting last year, the CHA board of directors proposed that the homeowner's association purchase three commercial swing sets to be placed in three separate, under-served areas on park property. The projected cost was approximately \$18,000. The motion passed overwhelmingly. Our CHA President Steve Roebuck along with Membership director Michael Zammaron met with parks officials, and the three sites were agreed upon.


After the City agreed to install the sets, put in curbing around them, and install safety surfacing, a refundable deposit was made on the sets. They were to be delivered right before the city was ready to install them.

A few days after the City people came to view and select the three sites, they came back and said that the city only wanted to build one new site, one with three different types of playground equipment that would appeal to several different age groups. The board had a goal of getting these swing sets in three separate locations of Candleridge where there is absolutely no playground equipment because CandleRidge is getting a lot of young couples moving here, and we wanted to do something for the kids. At a recent board meeting, it was the consensus of the Board that the city was reneging on its deal and that our homeowner's association was making the city a very generous offer to buy park equipment when other areas of the city are getting park equipment at no cost to their HOA.

Since time was quickly running out on getting our deposit back on the three swing sets, the Board voted to cancel the order. The order for the three swing sets is currently on hold until the membership votes to change the types of equipment needed for one playground site. In order to satisfy the Parks Department demands, we would need to spend another \$2,000 to \$4,000 to purchase the equipment needed. That total amount may run \$20,000 to \$22,000 instead of the original \$18,000.

This issue will be discussed further at the membership meeting September 28th.
